Rule: 5101:2-12-04 Food License

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to refrain from preparing and serving food as stated in their exemption from a food service license.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that food was prepared and served in violation of the terms of the program's food service license exemption report which stated the program was exempt as noted in number 3 below:

- 1. Prepares and serves no food;
- 2. Prepares and serves food to thirteen or fewer individuals daily;
- 3. Prepares no food but food is prepared and served by a licensed caterer as directed by Chapter 3717 ORC;

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to ensure all administrators, employees, child care staff members and school-age children wear a face covering while indoors, unless not medically or developmentally appropriate.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not follow the requirements for wearing face coverings as noted in number 3 below:

- 1. At least one administrator, child care staff member or employee did not wear a face covering while indoors and it was medically appropriate for the individual to wear a face covering.
- 2. At least one school-age child did not wear a face covering while indoors and it was medically and developmentally appropriate for the individual to wear a face covering.
- 3. At least one individual's face covering did not cover their nose and mouth.
- 4. At least one child under two years old wore a face covering.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store food in a safe manner.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that food was not stored in a safe manner as noted in number(s) [] below:

- 1. The refrigerator did not maintain a temperature of 40 degrees Fahrenheit or below;
- 2. Milk was not refrigerated for approximately () minutes after being served;
- 3. Food was observed thawing on the counter;
- 4. Other: The children's lunches were stored in the classroom. Some of the items in the sack lunches needed to be refrigerated.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide written nutritional information to parents and staff and have the information on file at the program.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a copy of written information supplied to parents/guardians and staff concerning nutritional criteria for meals and snacks was not on file. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

Code: The program is required to provide written nutritional information to parents and staff.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that parents/guardians and staff had not been provided with written nutritional information regarding the quantities and types of food needed to meet one-third of children's recommended dietary allowances. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Fluid Milk Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to obtain documentation from a licensed physician if an infant less than 12 months of age is served something other than formula or breast milk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that children less than 12 months were served something other than formula or breast milk, and there was no documentation from a licensed physician, physician assistant, or certified nurse practitioner on file to support this practice, as required by the rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

An 8 month old infant was served chocolate milk.

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the required one hour prescribed Child Abuse training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the requirement for the ODJFS one-hour prescribed Child Abuse Training was not met as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. The training was not completed within sixty days of hire;
- 2. The training expired, as it is only valid for two years;



3. Not all administrators, Child Care Staff Members, and substitutes have completed the training.

Code: The program is required to have a completed medical on file at the program for each child enrolled.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of 25% of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statements were not on file, as required, for children listed on the JFS Children's Record Review For Child Care as indicated in number 2 below:

- 1. No medical was on file for at least one child
- 2. Medical(s) on file were not updated every 13 months
- 3. Medical(s) were missing child's name and date of birth
- 4. Medical(s) were missing the date of the medical examination
- 5. Medical(s) were missing a statement that the child has been examined and is in suitable condition for participation in group care
- 6. Medical(s) were missing the signature, business address and telephone number of the physician, physician's assistant(PA), advance practice nurse (APN) or certified nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child
- 7. Medical(s) were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year
- 8. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases required by division 5104.014 of the Revised Code and found in appendix A to this rule
- 9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of conscience, including religious convictions
