Domain: 06 Program Information

Rule: 5101:2-12-14 Transportation - Vehicle Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to use the correct vehicle type as specified in rule. The program is also required to have all vehicles used to transport children inspected by an ASE certified mechanic annually, and correct all repairs that are listed on the vehicle inspection report.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program used a vehicle to transport children that was not approved and/or did not have a current annual vehicle inspection indicating the vehicle was mechanically safe as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. The program used a converted cargo van or passenger vans designed to carry ten or more passengers. The program must cease the use of this vehicle immediately.
- 2. The vehicle was not inspected. (Program's bus is in the shop for maintenance and the program used a child care staff members mini-van)
- 3. The vehicle was inspected by someone other than an ASE certified mechanic or other approved entity.
- 4. The vehicle inspection was not updated annually.
- 5. The vehicle inspection completed from the Ohio Highway Patrol did not meet the rule requirement.
- 6. The annual safety check of the vehicle(s) used by the program to transport children noted repairs or corrections that had not been completed and/or documented. The safety violations need to be corrected immediately.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes either discontinuing the use of the vehicle, documentation for any new vehicle now being used to transport children, or a copy of the JFS 01230 "Vehicle Inspection Report for Child Care Centers", to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-09 Background Check Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have documentation from ODJFS, indicating the individual is eligible to be employed in child care, on file before allowing the staff to have sole responsibility of children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that Child Care Staff Member(s) had sole responsibility of children in the school-age group and the JFS 01176 "Program Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care" was not on file as required. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the JFS 01176 or a statement that the Child Care Staff Member(s) no longer have sole responsibility of children, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to maintain a record of the arrival and departure of each child. The program is also required to retain the attendance record for a period of one year.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for keeping an attendance record as listed in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. No attendance record was being maintained;
- 2. The attendance record was not being consistently completed;
- 3. The attendance documentation was not kept at the program for a period of one year.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Ratio

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to post the staff to child ratios, age grouping, and maximum group size appendix in a noticeable area in the program.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection it was determined that Appendix A of this rule, "Staff/Child Ratios, Age Grouping and Maximum Group Size", was not posted in a noticeable area in the program. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the children's individual blankets and belongings were stored in an unsanitary manner. Blankets are stored piled together in the toddler 2 classroom. Children's belongings need to be stored in a sanitary manner to prevent the spread of germs. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

Rule: 5101:2-12-17 Daily Schedule

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have the daily program schedule posted in all required areas.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a copy of the daily program schedule was not posted in the classrooms as required. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements

Code: The program is required to have a space free from immediate risk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that an area was used which was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a fence in good repair, or other barrier. Although the fence or natural barrier was not meeting the rule requirements, it was determined to not present an immediate risk for a child to be able to leave the playground. The fence or gate was not in good repair and/or used appropriately as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The fencing had missing slat boards; (couple slat boards were loose and hanging)
- 2. The fencing was broken;
- 3. The fencing was loose;
- 4. The fencing was rotting;
- 5. The gate was broken and did not close;
- 6. The gate was padlocked;
- 7. The latch on the gate was broken;
- 8. The latch was easily opened by children on the playground;
- 9. The gate had no latch.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 06/03/2021

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Fall Zones

Code: The program is required to provide fall zones around equipment to prevent injury if a child were to fall.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the movable slides were positioned such that the fall zone for number 1 below was not met:

- 1. The fall zone did not extend six feet from the point of furthest extension;
- 2. The fall zone was less than 6 feet from fence;
- 3. The fall zone was less than 9 feet from each piece of applicable equipment;
- 4. There was not a fall zone of 6 feet in all directions from the perimeter of the equipment;
- 5. Other [].

The program is required to provide equipment that is safe with adequate fall zones. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 06 Program Information

Rule: 5101:2-12-14 Transportation and Field Trip Procedures

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to take all required safety and health items on trips.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that all required items were not taken on a field trip and/or routine trip as determined in that the item number(s) 2 below was missing:

- 1. Completed copies of the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care" (except routine walks);
- 2. First aid supplies;
- 3. A working cellular phone or other means of immediate communication (not to be used while a vehicle is in motion);
- 4. Written record of children on the trip, including which vehicle each child is being transported in and the cellular phone number of the adult in that vehicle who could be contacted in an emergency.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a written plan that ensures these safety guidelines will be met when children are transported, and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

Code: The program is required to have staff complete the required one hour prescribed Child Abuse training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the requirement for the ODJFS one-hour prescribed Child Abuse Training was not met as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. The training was not completed within sixty days of hire;
- 2. The training expired, as it is only valid for two years;
- 3. Not all administrators, Child Care Staff Members, and substitutes have completed the training.

Refer to the Employee Record Chart for the name(s) of the Child Care Staff Member(s) who must complete the ODJFS one-hour prescribed Child Abuse Training. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Orientation and Staff Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the online staff orientation training before they are permitted to have sole responsibility of children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that Child Care Staff Member(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart had sole responsibility of children and had not completed the online orientation, as required by this rule. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Medical Statement

<u>Code</u>: The program staff medicals are required to be completed and on file at the program.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that completed medical examination statement(s) for the employee(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart were not on file, as required by this rule. Submit the

program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program staff is required to have educational verification on file at the program.
