#### Domain:02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to have all surge protectors and outlets covered.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that multiple outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers. The program must have safety covers on all electrical outlets, including power strips and surge protectors, which are within the reach of the children. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain:05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Safe Food Handling/Storage

Code: The program is required to refrain from serving food on bare tables and to remove, clean, and sanitize highchair trays when food is served directly on the tray.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not implement safe food handling when serving food as noted in number 1 below:

1. Food was served on bare tables for the preschool group.

2. Food was served directly on highchair trays, and the trays were not removed, cleaned, and sanitized between use for the [ ] group.

#### Domain:07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

Code: The program is required to provide clean sheets for all cribs that are not too large or too small for the crib.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that sheets did not meet the rule requirement as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. At least one crib did not have a sheet.
- 2. At least one sheet was too large.
- 3. At least one sheet was too small.
- 4. At least one sheet was torn.
- 5. Crib sheets were not clean.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.



## Domain:07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

Code: The program is required to space cribs two feet apart when in use.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that cribs were not two feet apart when in use, as required by this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.
