<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item(s) or condition(s) which may threaten their health, safety, or well-being as noted in number(s) 12 below:

- 1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 2. Telephone cords.
- 3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 4. Stacked chairs.
- 5. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 6. Diaper bags.
- 7. Television not securely anchored.
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
- 10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: [ ].
- 12. Lighting not sufficient (entryway hall and common area).

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that at least one area of the program or at least one piece of equipment had chipping or peeling paint (walls in toddler room, schoolage room and preschool room and fence on playground). Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

## **Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

Code: The program is required to provide equipment and materials that are easy to clean.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one piece of equipment, furnishings, or material at the program was not constructed of materials to facilitate cleaning and sanitizing as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The material had a tear (sleeping mats for schoolagers);
- 2. The material was not washable;
- 3. The material was porous;
- 4. The surface was cracked;
- 5. The surface was repaired, but in a manner that still did not facilitate cleaning and sanitizing;
- 6. Other [ ].

Equipment, furnishings, and furniture shall be constructed of materials to facilitate cleaning and shall be kept clean and in good repair. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

#### **Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the following equipment, as noted in number(s) 3 and 4 below, was not being cleaned with soap and water and/or sanitized monthly, as required:

- 1. Cribs;
- 2. Dress-up clothes and hats;
- 3. Washable toys and equipment (dramatic play set in preschool);
- 4. Walls (schoolage room)

Furniture, materials and equipment must be maintained according to the cleaning and sanitizing schedule in Appendix A to this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

## **Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-17 Materials and Equipment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have enough equipment for all children in care.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment and materials in the following categories 3, 5, 8 were not provided in sufficient quantities for children in the classroom listed below, as required by the rule:

- 1. Art supplies (excludes infants);
- 2. Manipulative materials and equipment;
- 3. Blocks (infants);
- 4. Science-nature equipment (excludes infants);
- 5. Language arts and auditory materials and equipment (toddlers and infants no books accessible);
- 6. Pretend or dramatic play materials;
- 7. Music equipment;
- 8. Transportation materials and equipment (infants);
- 9. Gross motor equipment;
- 10. Sensory motor equipment.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

#### **Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space**

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements

Code: The program is required to have a space free from immediate risk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that an area was used which was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a fence in good repair, or other barrier. Although the fence or natural barrier was not meeting the rule requirements, it was determined to not present an immediate risk for a child to be able to leave the playground. The fence or gate was not in good repair and/or used appropriately as noted in number(s) 1 and 3 below:

- 1. The fencing had missing slat boards;
- 2. The fencing was broken;
- 3. The fencing was loose (not secure at the bottom in several areas);
- 4. The fencing was rotting;
- 5. The gate was broken and did not close;

- 6. The gate was padlocked;
- 7. The latch on the gate was broken;
- 8. The latch was easily opened by children on the playground;
- 9. The gate had no latch.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have an accurate menu posted.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the posted menu was not accurate as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The entire menu was substituted for breakfast;
- 2. Item on menu did not match what was served;
- 3. The meal or snack served did not match menu posted.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to include three food groups when serving breakfast.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the breakfast served at the program did not include foods from three of the four food groups. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to refrain from using televisions, computers, and other screens during meals and snacks.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection it was determined that the television was on during meals and snacks (lunch in the infant room). Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

**Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care** 

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide clean sheets for all cribs that are not too large or too small for the crib.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that sheets did not meet the rule requirement as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. At least one crib did not have a sheet.
- 2. At least one sheet was too large.
- 3. At least one sheet was too small.
- 4. At least one sheet was torn.
- 5. Crib sheets were not clean.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files** 

Rule: 5101:2-12-07 Administrator Responsibilities/Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program administrator is required to maintain current employee records in the Ohio Professional

Registry.



<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined employment records were not entered or updated within five calendar days of the change in the Ohio Professional Registry (OPR) as noted in number(s) 3 and 5 below:

- 1. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member (including substitutes) had not created an employment record in the OPR for the program.
- 2. The administrator had not assigned at least one employee or child care staff member to the program's organization dashboard in the OPR.
- 3. At least one individual's schedule was not current.
- 4. At least one individual's position or role was not current.
- 5. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.
- 6. Other: [ ]

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-25 Medication Administration and Food Supplements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have medication labeled with the child's name.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that medication (Desitin) was at the program which had not been labeled with the child's name. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-25 Medication Administration and Food Supplements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to use the appropriate form and retain current documentation to administer medications. The program is also required to obtain separate documentation for each medication and child, and retain on file each JFS 01217 "Request for Administration of Medication for Child Care" for at least one year.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for the JFS 01217 "Request for Administration of Medication for Child Care" as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The JFS 01217 was missing or incomplete for a topical product, food supplement, medical food.
- 2. The program used an old version of the JFS 01217.

- 3. The signature date on the JFS 01217 exceeded more than 12 months.
- 4. The time period to administer the medication on the JFS 01217 was exceeded.
- 5. The JFS 01217 included more than one medication.
- 6. The JFS 01217 included more than one child's name.
- 7. The JFS 01217 was not on file for one year.
- 8. The prescription label was not current.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-25 Medication Administration and Food Supplements

Code: The program is required to store medication out of the reach of children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a topical product, Desitin, was within the reach of children in the toddler room in that it was located in a cubby bin at child level. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.
