Rule: 5101:2-12-15 Medical/Physical Care Plans

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" on file at the program for any child having a health condition. The program is required to implement and/or follow instructions on the JFS 01236 for a child with a health condition.

<u>Finding</u>: A written, signed and dated JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" must be on file for any child having health conditions which require monitoring for symptoms, or a medical procedure be performed, or ongoing administration of medication or medical foods at the program. In review of the children's records, it was determined that the required written information was either not on file, implemented or followed, for at least one child indicated on the Children Records Review, as noted in number 19 below:

- 1. No plan was on file.
- 2. Child's name was missing.
- 3. Child's date of birth was missing.
- 4. Name of the condition was missing.
- 5. Indication if medication is required was missing.
- 6. Symptoms to watch for were missing.
- 7. Directions for when should the medication or medical food be administered were missing.

- 9. Conditions that trigger the need for medication or medical foods were missing.
- 10. Expected results of the medication or medical food were missing.
- 11. Actions to be taken if the symptoms do not subside were missing.
- 12. Activities, foods, environmental conditions to avoid were missing.
- 13. Training instructions were missing.

14. Directions for action to be taken if expected result of medication or medical food does not occur were missing.

- 15. Instructions regarding emergency evacuation, if applicable, were missing.
- 16. Dated signature of parent was missing.

17. Dated signature of certified professional who trained the program staff was missing, if parent was not the trainer.

18. Printed name(s)/Dated signature(s) of child care staff member(s) trained to perform the procedure were missing.

- 19. Dated signature of administrator was missing.
- 20. Name of any applicable medication was missing.
- 21. Date medication was administered was missing.
- 22. Time medication was administered was missing.
- 23. Dosage administered was missing.
- 24. Signature of staff member who administered the medication was missing.
- 25. Medication listed in the procedures to follow was not onsite available to administer as instructed and
- alternate instructions for this situation were not included on the plan.
- 26. The plan was not implemented.
- 27. The plan was not able to be implemented due to conflicting information.
- 28. The plan was not followed.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Handwashing Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide sinks with running water for handwashing.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the handwashing facility requirements were not met as noted in number 2 below:



- 1. There was no handwashing facility available.
- 2. The handwashing facility was out of order and not able to be used in that they did not drain and were clogged.
- 3. The non-permanent sink was not commercially manufactured.
- 4. The non-permanent sink's fresh and/or waste water was accessible to children.
- 5. The non-permanent sink's waste water was not disposed of in a sanitary manner.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following items or conditions which may threaten their health, safety, or well-being as noted in numbers 1,3 below:

- 1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 2. Telephone cords.
- 3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 4. Stacked chairs.
- 5. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 6. Diaper bags.
- 7. Television not securely anchored.
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
- 10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: [].
- 12. Other [].

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements <u>Code</u>: The program is required to conduct and document quarterly inspections of their outdoor play space.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that quarterly inspections of one or more outdoor play area and equipment had not been completed and documented as required, using the JFS 01281 "Child Care Playground Inspection Report" form. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 Emergency Drills

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to complete fire drills, weather drills, and emergency/lockdown drills appropriately.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the required drills were not completed for item numbers 1,2,3 below:

- 1. Monthly fire drills.
- 2. Monthly weather emergency drills (March through September).
- 3. Emergency/lockdown drills in each quarter of the calendar year.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-16 First Aid/Standard Precautions <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a first aid kit onsite.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined first aid kit at the program had missing, or expired, items that are required by appendix A of this rule to be contained in a first aid kit, as noted in numbers 9,12,13 below:



- 1. The program did not have a first aid kit [onsite, on the vehicle, on a field trip].
- 2. One roll of hypoallergenic first-aid tape.
- 3. Individually wrapped sterile gauze squares in assorted sizes.
- 4. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes.
- 5. Tweezers.
- 6. Gauze rolled bandage.
- 7. Triangular bandage.
- 8. Rounded end scissors.

9. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only).

- 10. A working digital thermometer.
- 11. Disposable non-latex gloves.
- 12. A working flashlight.

13. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit.

14. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids.

15. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration.

- 16. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only).
- 17. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to post the current weekly menu in a noticeable location that is accessible to parents and note any substitutions at the time of the change.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's weekly menu did not meet the requirement as noted in number 1 below.

- 1. The menu was not posted.
- 2. The posted menu was not in a visible place readily accessible to parents.
- 3. The menu was not currently dated.
- 4. The entire menu was substituted.
- 5. At least one item on menu did not match what was served.
- 6. The meal or snack served did not match the posted menu.

Domain: 06 Program Information

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-14 Transportation and Field Trip Procedures

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to take all required safety and health items on trips.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that all required items were not taken on a field trip and/or routine trip as determined in that the item number 2 below was missing:

1. Completed copies of the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care" (except routine walks);

2. First aid supplies;

3. A working cellular phone or other means of immediate communication (not to be used while a vehicle is in motion);

4. Written record of children on the trip, including which vehicle each child is being transported in and the cellular phone number of the adult in that vehicle who could be contacted in an emergency.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a written plan that ensures these safety guidelines will be met when children are transported, and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-14 Transportation and Field Trip Procedures <u>Code</u>: The program is required to obtain written parental permission before leaving the premises.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that written parental permission was not secured for field trips and/or routine trips off the premises or out of the areas approved for child care, as required. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.



Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all child care staff members complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire. Staff must complete training in first aid and CPR within the first ninety days of hire.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member had not completed required health and safety training as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. Child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
- 2. First aid training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 3. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 4. The child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was expired.
- 5. The first aid training was expired.
- 6. The CPR training was expired.
