#### Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-20 Crib and Playpen Requirements

Code: The program is required to remove an infant from a crib to sleep if the infant is able to climb out of the crib, is 35" tall or more, or if the crib is considered hazardous for the infant.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an infant was placed in a crib/playpen and the condition in number 1, 2 had been met:

1. The child is able to climb out of the crib/playpen;
2. The child is 35" tall or more;
3. The crib/playpen is considered hazardous

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.
