Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the method for tracking children in each group did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number 4 below:

1. There was no method in place;
2. The method did not include each child's name;
3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;(Zoologist and Little Learners were on the playground without a tracking method)
5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group.
