Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an infant was placed in a crib with the following suffocation or strangulation hazard: bib around neck with a pacifier attached to a strap and attached to the child. . Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.
