Allegation: At the time of the inspection an infant child was observed laying in a crib with a bib around around their neck and a pacifier attached to a strap attached to the child

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an infant was placed in a crib with the following suffocation or strangulation hazard: bib around neck with a pacifier attached to a strap and attached to the child. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.
