**Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision** 

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have the information listed in rule on all attendance records.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the attendance records did not include the required information listed in number 2 and 4 below:

- 1. The name of the child.
- 2. The birth date of the child.
- 3. The assigned group.
- 4. The child's weekly schedule.
- 5. The time (hours and minutes) of each child's arrival and departure to the program, including transportation by the program.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

### **Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Handwashing Requirements

Code: The program is required to have all children wash their hands as outlined in rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one child in the School Age group did not wash his or her hands at the time listed in numbers 1 and 2 below, as required in rule.

- 1. Upon arrival.
- 2. Prior to departure.
- 3. After toileting/diaper change.
- 4. After contact with bodily fluids.
- 5. After returning from outdoor play.
- 6. After handling pets, pet cages, or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet, before moving on to another activity.
- 7. Before eating or assisting with food preparation.
- 8. After water activities.
- 9. When visibly soiled (must use soap and water)
- 10. Other [ ].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements

Code: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from immediate risk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that an area was used which was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a fence in good repair, or other barrier. Although the fence or natural barrier was not meeting the rule requirements, it was determined to not present an immediate risk for a child to be able to leave the playground. The fence or gate was not in good repair and/or being used inappropriately as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. The fencing had missing slat boards.
- 2. The fencing was broken and not continuous to cover all needed sides.
- 3. The fencing was loose.
- 4. The fencing was rotting.
- 5. The gate was broken and did not close.
- 6. The gate was locked.
- 7. The latch on the gate was broken.
- 8. The latch was easily opened by children on the playground.
- 9. The gate had no latch.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member had not completed training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. The training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
- 2. The training was expired, as it is only valid for two years.

Refer to the Employee Record Chart for the name(s) of the child care staff member(s) who must complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that Child Care Staff Member(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart had sole responsibility of children and had not completed the online orientation, as required by this rule. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to maintain a staff schedule with coverage of the required health trainings.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined the program did not have at least one child care staff member present/scheduled to be present during all hours of operation with currently valid documentation for the training(s) listed in number 4 below:

- 1. First Aid child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] had expired training
- 2. First Aid child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [ ] and [ ] did not have verification of completion of First Aid
- 3. First Aid trained child care staff member was not present in each building used by the program.
- 4. CPR child care staff members scheduled during the hours of 6:30 and 8:00am and 5:00 and 6:00 pm had expired training
