<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-25 Medication Administration and Food Supplements <u>Code</u>: The program is required to store medication out of the reach of children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a medication stored in classroom backpacks were within the reach of children in the Rangers & Explorers 1 room as they were stored on the floor in the classrooms. All medications must be stored out of the reach of children. Create procedures that assure medications will always be inaccessible to children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment Code: The program is required to clean equipment throughout the day if dirty or soiled.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following equipment was unclean or soiled during daily use: trash cans in the boys & girls bathrooms. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Fluid Milk Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to obtain documentation from a licensed physician if a child over 24 months of age is to be served anything other than one percent or skim milk that is Vitamin A and D fortified.



<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that there was no documentation from a licensed physician, physician's assistant, or certified nurse practitioner as required by the rule, when children over 24 months of age were served anything other than one percent or skim milk that is Vitamin A and D fortified. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the required one hour prescribed Child Abuse training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the requirement for the ODJFS one-hour prescribed Child Abuse Training was not met as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. The training was not completed within sixty days of hire;
- 2. The training expired, as it is only valid for two years;
- 3. Not all administrators, Child Care Staff Members, and substitutes have completed the training.
