Rule: 5101:2-12-04 Fire Approval

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to only use space approved by the fire department or the state fire marshal's office to serve children. The program is required to obtain a fire inspection within 12 months from the date of the last fire approval. If violations are noted during the inspection, the program is required to have all violations corrected and have the program re-inspected to obtain a completed fire form.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program had not obtained written approval from the local fire safety inspector or the state fire marshal as noted in number 1 below:

1. The program did not have verification of having been inspected and approved within 12 months from the date of the last fire approval and the request for the new inspection was not made at least 30 days prior to the expiration of the previous approval.

2. The fire approval had not been obtained due to violations.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the attendance records did not include the required information listed in numbers 1-4 below:

1. The name of the child.

2. The birth date of the child.

- 3. The assigned group.
- 4. The child's weekly schedule.

5. The time (hours and minutes) of each child's arrival and departure to the program, including transportation by the program.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the method for tracking children in each group did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. There was no method in place;
- 2. The method did not include each child's name;
- 3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
- 4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;
- 5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to conduct and document quarterly inspections of their outdoor play space.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that quarterly inspections of the outdoor play area and equipment had not been completed and documented as required, using the JFS 01281 "Child Care Playground Inspection Report" form. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Fluid Milk Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to obtain documentation from a licensed physician if a child over 24 months of age is to be served anything other than one percent or skim milk that is Vitamin A and D fortified.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that there was no documentation from a licensed physician, physician's assistant, or certified nurse practitioner as required by the rule, when children over 24 months of age were served anything other than one percent or skim milk that is Vitamin A and D fortified. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the medical statements for those employees listed on the Employee Record Chart did not include the required information listed below in number 1.

1. Date of examination;

2. Signature, business address, and telephone number of the licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice nurse, certified midwife, or certified nurse practitioner who completed the examination;

- 3. A statement that verifies that the employee is:
- a. Physically fit for employment in a program caring for children;
- b. Immunized against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap);
- c. Immunized against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR);
- 4. Tuberculosis (TB) screening/test

a. Documentation of the screening process to determine if the employee resided in a country identified by the World Health Organization as having a high burden of TB and arrived in the United States within the five years preceding the date of application for employment;

- b. Results of a TB test for employees meeting both criteria in 4a;
- c. Results of additional testing for employees with a positive TB test;

d. Written statement, signed by a representative of the TB control unit, that the employee's TB is no longer infectious or the individual is receiving a TB treatment regimen for employees with a positive TB test.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, or TB results/documentation, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
