- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.

- 8. Emergency information including any medications or supplies needed in the event of an evacuation was not complete.
- 9. The current version of the prescribed form was not used.
- 10. The plan was not implemented when necessary in that [].

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 Incident/Injury Reporting

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to notify the Department of a serious incident by submitting a JFS 01156 "Serious Incident Reporting for Child Care".

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a Serious Incident was not reported in the Ohio Child Licensing and Quality System (OCLQS), as required, by the program administrator or designee for an incident(s) as listed in number(s) 5 below:

- 1. A child received a bump or blow to the head that required first aid or medical attention.
- 2. An incident, injury or illness that required a child to be removed by the parent or emergency services from the program for medical treatment.
- 3. A usual or unexpected incident which jeopardizes the safety of a child or employee of the program.
- 4. An incident defined as a serious risk noncompliance in appendix A to rule 5101:2-12-03 of the Administrative Code.
- 5. The program did not submit the report in the OCLQS by the next business day as required by rule.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that completed medical examination statement(s) for the employee(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart was not on file, as required by this rule. Medical was viewed as completed after the onsite inspection. Program does not need to submit completed physical form. <u>Finding</u>: In review of 25% of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statements were not on file, as required, for children listed on the JFS Children's Record Review For Child Care as indicated in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. No medical was on file for at least one child
- 2. Medical(s) on file were not updated every 13 months
- 3. Medical(s) were missing child's name and date of birth
- 4. Medical(s) were missing the date of the medical examination
- 5. Medical(s) were missing a statement that the child has been examined and is in suitable condition for participation in group care
- 6. Medical(s) were missing the signature, business address and telephone number of the physician, physician's assistant(PA), advance practice nurse (APN) or certified nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child
- 7. Medical(s) were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year
- 8. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases required by division 5104.014 of the Revised Code and found in appendix A to this rule
- 9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of conscience, including religious convictions
