Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to protect children from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined the program did not protect children from an unsafe item or condition or equipment due to the following number(s) 2 below:

1. Pull cord(s) on the window blind(s).

- 2. electrical cord(s) attached to an object that could result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 3. Stacked tables.
- 4. Folding tables.
- 5. Matches and/or a lighter.
- 6. Power tool(s).

- 8. Stove(s) that are either on or able to be turned on by a child.
- 9. Asbestos.

Code: The program staff is required to protect the children from hazardous conditions in the outdoor play area.

- 3. There was poison ivy.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the children were not provided with any provider identification while on a field trip and/or routine trip. The identification must include the program's name, address, and a telephone number to contact in the event the child becomes lost. 9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases
