Moderate Risk Non-Compliances

Domain:01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Ratio

Code: The program is required to maintain the appropriate staff to child ratio for each group served.

Findings: During the inspection, a ratio of 2 child care staff members for 13 children was determined to have occurred for the Infant group when the situation in number(s) 15 below occurred:

1. A child care staff member stepped out of the room.

- 2. A child care staff member had not arrived at work on time.
- 3. Children were present who were not scheduled to be there.
- 4. A child care staff member was unable to work.



5. A child was injured in that group.

6. A child arrived in the group before a second staff member was scheduled to arrive with the group.

7. Two groups were combined, and the program did not follow the ratio for the youngest child in the group.

8. A child was transitioning to the next older age group, and the program did not follow the ratio for the youngest child in the group.

9. Ratio was doubled for more than two hours while children were napping.

10. Ratio was doubled while children were napping for a group that included at least one infant.

11. Ratio was doubled while children were napping and there were not enough staff members in the building to meet staff/child ratio.

12. Ratio was doubled in the school age group to allow access to the program, however, the program does not serve only school age children.

13. Both child care staff members did not have a working communication device when one staff member left the group to allow access to the school age only program.

14. The child care staff member did not return to the group after allowing access to the school age only program.

15. Other: The classroom had too many children enrolled in the classroom and more than 12 were present on the day of the inspection.

Additional child care staff members must be hired or current child care staff members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain:01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Group Size

Code: The program is required to maintain the appropriate group size for each group of children served.

Findings: During the inspection, group size limitations were not maintained for the group of infants as it was determined there were 13 children grouped together and in the group of Infant II and it was determined that there were 21 children grouped together in the group of toddlers. The group size shall not exceed twice the maximum number of children allowed per Child Care Staff Member. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 05/25/2022

Domain:04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Separation of Children Under 2 1/2 Years Code: The program is required to separate children younger and older than 2 1/2 years of age.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that 21 children were in attendance in the Get Set room at one time. The floor space allows for 18 children in this room. The program needs to reduce the number of children in attendance so there is 35 square feet of space for each child. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.



Note: Please be reminded that all of your infant and toddler rooms only allow for a maximum of 17 children except the Get Setters room which can hold 18.
