Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store chemicals and machinery in a place that is inaccessible to children. The program is required to provide an outdoor play area away from machinery in operation.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored in janitors closet with door propped open with was off of the cafeteria where children had access to it, as noted in number(s) 2,5,7,9,14 below.

- 1. Bleach.
- 2. Cleaning agent.
- 3. Fish tank chemicals.
- 4. Gasoline.
- 5. Pesticide.
- 6. Poison, including insect/rodent poison.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that background checks were not requested for the person(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart as noted in number 1,2 below:

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a method for tracking the children in each group. The tracking method must be updated throughout the day and kept with the group at all times.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the method for tracking children in each group did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. There was no method in place;
- 2. The method did not include each child's name;
- 3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
- 4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;
- 5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item(s) or condition(s) which may threaten their health, safety, or well-being as noted in number 5 below:

- 1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 2. Telephone cords.
- 3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 4. Stacked chairs.
- 5. Employee(s) purse/backpack.
- 6. Diaper bags.
- 7. Television not securely anchored.
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
- 10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: [].
- 12. Other [].

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to provide equipment that does not pose a safety risk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was observed that the swing set posed a safety risk, in that one swing seat was broke in half. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 First Aid/Standard Precautions

Code: The program is required to have a first aid kit onsite.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined first aid kit(s) at the program had missing, or expired, items that are required by appendix A of this rule to be contained in a first aid kit, as noted in number 4 below:

- 1. The program did not have a first aid kit [onsite, on the vehicle, on a field trip].
- 2. One roll of hypoallergenic first-aid tape.
- 3. Individually wrapped sterile gauze squares in assorted sizes.
- 4. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes.
- 5. Tweezers.
- 6. Gauze rolled bandage.
- 7. Triangular bandage.
- 8. Rounded end scissors.
- 9. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only).
- 10. A working digital thermometer.
- 11. Disposable non-latex gloves.
- 12. A working flashlight.
- 13. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit.
- 14. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids.
- 15. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration.
- 16. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only).
- 17. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to complete all information on the JFS 01299 "Incident/Injury Report For Child Care."

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the records, it was determined that a JFS 01299 "Incident/Injury Report For Child Care" form was missing information as noted in number 1,11 below:

- 1. Program information (program name, number, address);
- 2. Child's name;
- 3. Child's birth date;
- 4. Name of person(s) responsible for the child at the time of the incident;
- 5. Number of children present in the group at the time of the incident;
- 6. Date and/or time of the incident;
- 7. Whether or not parents were contacted;
- 8. Complete summary of the incident;
- 9. Accurate summary of the incident;
- 10. Name and/or signature of the person completing the form;
- 11. Does child have medical care plan was blank, must answer yes or no.

Rule: 5101:2-12-07 Administrator Responsibilities/Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program administrator is required to maintain current employee records in the Ohio Professional Registry.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined employment records in the Ohio Professional Registry (OPR) were not created or maintained as noted in numbers 1,2,5,6 below:

- 1. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member (including substitutes) had not created a profile.
- 2. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member had not created an employment record for the program on or before their first day of employment.
- 3. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member had not updated changes to positions or roles within five calendar days of the change.
- 4. The administrator had not assigned at least one employee or child care staff member to the program's organization dashboard.
- 5. At least one individual's schedule was not current.
- 6. At least one individual's position or role did not include an applicable group assignment.
- 7. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.
