Code: The program is required to provide adequate fall surface for the outdoor play space.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the playground did not have adequate fall surface under and around equipment as noted in numbers 1 and 2 below:

1. No fall surface

2. Adequate fall surface to soften the impact of a fall

3. Adequate fall surface to soften the impact of a fall that extended the length of the required fall zone 4. Other [ ]

With any equipment designed for climbing, swinging, bouncing, or sliding, resilient material, as specified in Appendix A, needs to be added in order to protect children in the event of a fall. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes written verification of the discontinued use of this equipment until corrections are made along with a description of the resilient material added, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Finding: A written, signed and dated JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" must be on file for any child having health conditions which require monitoring for symptoms, or a medical procedure be performed, or ongoing administration of medication or medical foods at the program. In review of the children's records, it was determined that the required written information was either not on file, implemented or followed, for at least one child indicated on the Children Records Review, as noted in numbers 16 - 19 and 28 below:

- 15. Instructions regarding emergency evacuation, if applicable, were missing.
- 16. Dated signature of parent was missing.

17. Dated signature of certified professional who trained the program staff was missing, if parent was not the trainer.

- 18. Printed names Dated signatures of child care staff members trained to perform the procedure were missing.
- 19. Dated signature of administrator was missing.
- 20. Name of any applicable medication was missing.
- 21. Date medication was administered was missing.
- 22. Time medication was administered was missing.
- 23. Dosage administered was missing.
- 24. Signature of staff member who administered the medication was missing.
- 25. Medication listed in the procedures to follow was not onsite available to administer as instructed and alternate instructions for this situation were not included on the plan.
- 26. The plan was not implemented.
- 27. The plan was not able to be implemented due to conflicting information.
- 28. The plan was not followed.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed JFS 01236, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have the information listed in rule on all attendance records.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the attendance records did not include the required information listed in number 4 below:

- 1. The name of the child.
- 2. The birth date of the child.
- 3. The assigned group.
- 4. The child's weekly schedule.

5. The time (hours and minutes) of each child's arrival and departure to the program, including transportation by the program.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment <u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number 9 below, were in the school age and preschool restrooms:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet paper.
- 3. There were no paper towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilet(s) were not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.
- 9. Other; Trash on floor in school age and preschool restrooms.

The restrooms must be kept sanitary at all times. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.



## Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide nonskid rugs and correct any floor hazard that may be unsafe.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program had an area rug that did not have a nonskid backing; A walking surface that is not hazardous to children must be maintained at the program. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

# Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to post and implement the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan" when necessary.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the requirements for the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan for Child Care" were not followed as noted in number 8 below:

- 1. The plan was not posted in each classroom.
- 2. The plan was not posted in other spaces used by children.
- 3. The name, address and telephone number of the program were not complete.

4. The location of first aid kit, fire extinguishers and fire alarm system, fire alarm pull stations and electrical circuit box were not complete.

5. The telephone number for emergency squad, fire department, hospital, poison control program, public children services agency, local health department, local emergency management agency, and police department were not complete.

6. Location of children's records was not complete.

7. Emergency information including any medications or supplies needed in the event of an evacuation was not complete.

8. The current version of the prescribed form was not used.

9. The plan was not implemented when necessary in that [ ].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

### **Domain: 06 Program Information**

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-14 Transportation - Driver Requirements <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have children and staff practice and document safely exiting vehicles during an emergency.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program had not conducted and/or documented monthly emergency exiting drills on vehicles with children, including the date of the drill and all staff who transport children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

# Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all child care staff members complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire. Staff must complete training in first aid and CPR within the first ninety days of hire.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member had not completed required health and safety training as noted in numbers 2, 3 and 4 below:

- 1. Child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
- 2. First aid training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 3. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 4. The child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was expired.
- 5. The first aid training was expired.
- 6. The CPR training was expired.

Refer to the Employee Record Chart for the names of the child care staff members who must complete the required health and safety trainings. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-08 Orientation Training & Whistle Blower Protection <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the online staff orientation training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that child care staff member(s) had not completed the online orientation training as noted in number 1 below:

1. Within 30 days of starting employment at the program as a child care staff member.

- 2. No documentation of completing the training after December 31, 2016.
- 3. Completion of the training was not verified in the OPR.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the child care staff member listed on the Employee Record Chart, who had completed a course of home school education, did not have on file a letter from the district in which the student resides indicating the student was excused from attendance during the final year of home education. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the letter, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

### Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Professional Development Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to ensure child care staff members, including substitutes used more than ninety days annually, obtain at least 6 hours of professional development each state fiscal year.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member did not meet the annual professional development requirement as noted in number 1 below:



1. The child care staff member had not completed at least six hours of professional development.

2. Documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule.

3. Training topic did not meet the requirements listed in appendix A of this rule.

4. Documentation of training did not meet the requirements of this rule.

5. The substitute(s) had been used more than ninety days annually between July first and June thirtieth and had not completed at least six hours of professional development

6. Other [ ].

1. No medical was on file for at least one child

- 2. Medical(s) on file was not updated every 13 months
- 3. Medical(s) were missing child's name and date of birth
- 4. Medical(s) were missing the date of the medical examination
- 5. The date of the exam was more than 13 months prior to the date the form was signed.

6. Medical(s) were missing a statement that the child has been examined and is in suitable condition for participation in group care

7. Medical(s) were missing the signature, business address and telephone number of the physician, physician's assistant(PA), advance practice nurse (APN) or certified

nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child

8. Medicals were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year

9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases

required by division 5104.014 of the Revised Code and found in appendix A to this rule



10. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of conscience, including religious convictions
