Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child care staff member used a discipline technique to guide or discipline a child that was not developmentally appropriate. The hand-over-hand technique was used to pick up toys, and the child was not calm at the time. The allegation was confirmed through conducting staff interviews and viewing video recordings.
