Rule: 5101:2-12-19 Supervision

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to supervise children in their assigned group by sight and hearing. Supervision includes being near enough to respond and reach children immediately and protecting them from harm.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that children were left unattended while inside the program as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. Children were left unattended once. Sitting in the hallway on a bench while staff member was in the restroom assisting another child.
- 2. Child(ren) were left unattended more than once.
- 3. Child(ren) left the group and were unattended.

- 4. Child care staff were using a baby monitor to supervise children.
- 5. Child care staff were using a walkie talkie to supervise children.
- 6. Child care staff were using mirrors to view children in another room.
- 7. Child care staff were using a video camera instead of physically being present in the room.

Children must be supervised and within sight and hearing of a child care staff member at all times. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored where children had access to it, as noted in number 2 & 9 below.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one staff member with the Younger Toddler group did not wash his or her hands at the time listed in number 6 below, as required in rule.

- 1. Upon arrival for the day.
- 2. Prior to departure.
- 3. Upon entry into a classroom.
- 4. After toileting or assisting a child with toileting.
- 5. After each diaper change or pull-up change.
- 6. After contact with bodily fluids or cleaning up spills or objects contaminated with bodily fluids. Wiping the nose's of two children
- 7. After cleaning or sanitizing or using any chemical products.
- 8. After handling pets, pet cages or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet.
- 9. Before eating, serving or preparing food or bottles or feeding a child.
- 10. Before and after completing a medical procedure or administering medication.
- 11. When visibly soiled (must use soap and water).
- 12. Other [].

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide food that does not pose as a choking hazard and is appropriate for the age of the children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the older toddler and preschool groups were served wholes grapes (sent from home), which posed a choking hazard. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member had not completed training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. The training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
- 2. The training was expired, as it is only valid for two years.

- 2. Signature, business address, and telephone number of the licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice nurse, certified midwife, or certified nurse practitioner who completed the examination;

- a. Physically fit for employment in a program caring for children;
- b. Immunized against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap);
- c. Immunized against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR);
- 4. Tuberculosis (TB) screening/test (D.R.)
- a. Documentation of the screening process to determine if the employee resided in a country identified by the World Health Organization as having a high burden of TB and arrived in the United States within the five years preceding the date of application for employment;
- b. Results of a TB test for employees meeting both criteria in 4a;
- c. Results of additional testing for employees with a positive TB test;
- d. Written statement, signed by a representative of the TB control unit, that the employee's TB is no longer infectious or the individual is receiving a TB treatment regimen for employees with a positive TB test.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, or TB results/documentation, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
