<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's weekly menu did not meet the requirement as noted in number(s) 1 below, in that the menu was a day to day menu, not a weekly menu.

- 1. The menu was not posted.
- 2. The posted menu was not in a visible place readily accessible to parents.
- 3. The menu was not currently dated.
- 4. The entire menu was substituted.
- 5. At least one item on menu did not match what was served.
- 6. The meal or snack served did not match the posted menu.
