Rule: 5101:2-12-04 Fire Inspection

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all spaces used for child care inspected by the fire department or the state fire marshal's office prior to serving children. The program is required to obtain a fire inspection without any uncorrected violations within 12 months from the date of the last fire inspection. If violations are noted during the inspection, the program is required to have all violations corrected and have the program reinspected to obtain a completed fire form.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for fire inspection as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. The program did not have documentation on file for a fire inspection without any uncorrected violations within 12 months from the date of the last fire inspection and the request for the new inspection was not made at least 30 days prior to the expiration of the previous fire inspection.
- 2. The documentation for the most recent fire inspection contained violations that had not been corrected.
- 3. The [] space was being used and had not been approved by the fire department or the state fire marshal's office for child care.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store chemicals and machinery in a place that is inaccessible to children. The program is required to provide an outdoor play area away from machinery in operation.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored in the children's hallway where children had access to it, as noted in number 2 below.

- 1. Bleach.
- 2. Cleaning agent. It was observed that a spray mop filled with a liquid cleaner was left sitting in the hallway.
- 3. Fish tank chemicals.
- 4. Gasoline.
- 5. Pesticide.
- 6. Poison, including insect/rodent poison.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous substance or item is no longer accessible to children and/or children will not be outside when machinery is in use and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-09 Background Check Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all staff request background checks as required and receive a JFS 01176 or preliminary approval from ODJFS prior to allowing an individual to engage in assigned duties or be near children.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that background checks did not meet the requirements of the rule for the person listed on the Employee Record Chart as noted in number 3 below:

- 1. The request for a background check for child care was not submitted in the OPR.
- 2. The fingerprints were not submitted electronically according to the process established by BCI.
- 3. The individual had engaged in assigned duties or were near children and preliminary approval from ODJFS was not on file.
- 4. Background checks were not updated every five years.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the JFS 01176, or a copy of the preliminary approval or a statement that the individual are no longer engaged in assigned duties and are not near children until the preliminary approval has been received, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-15 Medical/Physical Care Plans

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" on file at the program for any child having a health condition and must implement and/or follow instructions on the plan. The program is required to have staff trained to perform the procedures on the JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" present at the program when the child requiring the procedure is onsite. Only staff who have been trained shall be permitted to perform the procedures listed on the JFS 01236.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the children's records, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for caring for at least one child, indicated on the Children Records Review, with a condition that requires a JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" as noted in numbers 1, 30,31,32,33 below:

1. No plan was on file.

- 14. Expiration date for medication/medical food was missing or not attached.
- 15. Symptoms that require staff to administer medication/medical food were missing or not attached.
- 16. Specific instructions to administer the medication/medical food were missing or not attached.
- 17. Actions to be taken if the symptoms do not subside were missing or not attached.
- 18. Physician's signature was missing or not attached.
- 19. The date of the physician's signature was missing or not attached.

- 20. Child's name was missing.
- 21. Instructions regarding emergency evacuation, if applicable, were missing.
- 22. Signature of parent granting permission to implement the plan and verifying training was missing.
- 23. Date of parent signature was missing.
- 24. Certified Professional Trainer information was missing.
- 25. Signature of certified professional who trained the program staff was missing, if parent was not the trainer.
- 26. Date of trainer signature was missing.
- 27. Printed name(s)of child care staff member(s) who have received instructions for care and/or have been trained to perform the procedure were missing.
- 28. Signature(s) of child care staff member(s) who have received instructions for care and/or have been trained to perform the procedure were missing.
- 29. Date of staff signature was missing.
- 30. Administrator/Provider signature was missing
- 31. Date of administrator/Provider was missing.

- 32. Child's name was missing.
- 33. Name of medication or medical food was missing.
- 34. Date the medication/medical food was administered was missing.
- 35. Time medication/medical food was administered was missing.
- 36. Dosage of medication/medical food that was administered was missing.
- 37. Signature of person administering medication/medical food was missing.

- 38. The plan was not followed or implemented.
- 39. The plan was not able to be implemented due to conflicting information.
- 40. None of the child care staff members trained in the procedures on the JFS 01236 were onsite when a child requiring the plan was present.
- 41. Child care staff members trained in the procedures on the JFS 01236 were not scheduled to be present the entire the time the child requiring the plan was onsite.
- 42. None of the child care staff members trained in the procedures on the JFS 01236 accompanied the child requiring the plan during a trip.
- 43. A child care staff member who had not been trained in the procedures on the JFS 01236 performed the procedure.
- 44. Medication listed in the procedures to follow was not onsite available to administer as instructed and alternate instructions for this situation were not included on the plan.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed JFS 01236, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan

Code: The program is required to post and implement the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency

Plan" when necessary.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the requirements for the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan for Child Care" were not followed as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. The plan was not posted in each classroom.
- 2. The plan was not posted in other spaces used by children. Page one was posted /page two was missing in the gym.
- 3. The name, address and telephone number of the program were not complete.
- 4. The location of first aid kit, fire extinguishers and fire alarm system, fire alarm pull stations and electrical circuit box were not complete.
- 5. The telephone number for emergency squad, fire department, hospital, poison control program, public children services agency, local health department, local emergency management agency, and police department were not complete.
- 6. Location of children's records was not complete.



- 7. Emergency information including any medications or supplies needed in the event of an evacuation was not complete.
- 8. The current version of the prescribed form was not used.
- 9. The plan was not implemented when necessary in that [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan Code: The program is required to post the fire and weather plans.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following information was not posted for item number 1 below:

- 1. Fire alert plan, including a diagram indicating evacuation routes. In the gym.
- 2. Weather alert plan was missing details for [].
- 3. Weather alert plan was missing a diagram indicating evacuation routes.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 Emergency Drills

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to complete fire drills, weather drills, and emergency/lockdown drills appropriately.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the required drills were not completed for item number 3 below:

- 1. Monthly fire drills.
- 2. Monthly weather emergency drills (March through September).
- 3. Emergency/lockdown drills in each quarter of the calendar year. No documentation of lockdown drills.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 02/11/2024

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Professional Development Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to ensure child care staff members, including substitutes used more than ninety days annually, obtain at least 6 hours of professional development each state fiscal year.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member did not meet the annual professional development requirement as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. The child care staff member had not completed at least six hours of professional development within the fiscal year 7-1-2022 through 6-30-2023.
- 2. Documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule.
- 3. Training topic did not meet the requirements listed in appendix A of this rule.
- 4. Documentation of training did not meet the requirements of this rule.
- 5. The substitute(s) had been used more than ninety days annually between July first and June thirtieth and had not completed at least six hours of professional development
- 6. Other [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Medical Statement

<u>Code</u>: The program staff's medical statements are required to be completed and on file at the program.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the medical statements for the employees listed on the Employee Record Chart did not meet the requirements as listed in number 1,5c,6a below.

1. A medical statement was not on file for at least one employee;

- 2. The medical statement(s) on file did not have a date of examination within 12 months of the employee's first day of employment;
- 3. Date of examination was missing;
- 4. Signature, business address, or telephone number of the licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice nurse, certified midwife, or certified nurse practitioner who completed the examination was missing;
- 5. A statement was missing that verifies the employee is:
- a. Physically fit for employment in a program caring for children;
- b. Immunized against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap);
- c. Immunized against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR);
- 6. Tuberculosis (TB) screening/test information was missing:
- a. Documentation of the screening process to determine if the employee resided in a country identified by the world health organization as having a high burden of TB and arrived in the United States within the five years preceding the date of application for employment.
- b. Results of a TB test for employees meeting both criteria in 6a.
- c. Results of additional testing for employees with a positive TB test.
- d. Written statement, signed by a representative of the TB control unit, that the employee's TB is no longer infectious or the individual is receiving a TB treatment regimen for employees with a positive TB test.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, or TB results/documentation, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 02/11/2024

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all child care staff members complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire. Staff must complete training in first aid and CPR within the first ninety days of hire.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member had not completed required health and safety training as noted in numbers 2&3 below:

- 1. Child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
- 2. First aid training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 3. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 4. The child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was expired.
- 5. The first aid training was expired.
- 6. The CPR training was expired.

Refer to the Employee Record Chart for the names of the child care staff members who must complete the required health and safety trainings. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to remove all medication, medical foods and topical products that are no longer being administered or have expired. The program is also required to maintain current documentation to administer medications, medical foods and topical products.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that medication, medical foods and/or topical products did not meet the requirement(s) for administering medication, medical foods, and/or medical products as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. The medication, medical food, or topical product was no longer needed and had not been removed from the program. Diazepam (child no longer attends).
- 2. The medication, medical food, or topical product had expired and had not been removed from the program.
- 3. The prescription label had expired.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

- 7. Medical was missing the signature, business address and telephone number of the physician, physician's assistant(PA), advance practice nurse (APN) or certified nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child
- 8. Medical(s) were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year
- 9. Medical were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases

- 10. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of conscience, including religious convictions
