Complaint Allegations

Code: The program staff shall use developmentally appropriate techniques when managing children's behavior. Corporal punishment is prohibited, as well as any cruel, harsh, unusual or extreme techniques.

Allegation: Staff used inappropriate guidance and management techniques.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child care staff member used a discipline technique to guide or discipline child that was not developmentally appropriate, consistent, or occurred at the time of the incident. A staff member guided a 12 month year old away from the gate by inappropriately grabbing them by the upper arm. The staff person was holding another infant at the time and was trying to prevent the 12 month old from getting their foot stuck under the gate. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
