Complaint Allegations

Code: The program staff shall use developmentally appropriate techniques when managing children's behavior. Corporal punishment is prohibited, as well as any cruel, harsh, unusual or extreme techniques.

Allegation: A child care staff member used inappropriate guidance and management techniques including yelling and handling children roughly.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child care staff member used a discipline technique to guide or discipline children that was not developmentally appropriate, consistent, or occurred at the time of the incident. During the investigation it was confirmed that a child care staff member had yelled at children and handled children roughly when guiding them into a chair or onto a cot. Video was requested but was unavailable for review.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
