Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a Child Care Staff Member had abused, endangered, or neglected a child. A teacher shoved a child's face into a pillow and held them down on their cot so that they could not get up. The staff person forcefully held the child down with their face in the pillow, covered by a blanket. Child Care Staff Members, administrators, and owners must always use appropriate guidance and management methods with children and ensure that children are safe at all times. The individual needs to be released from employment immediately. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the individual is no longer employed, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
