The group size shall not exceed twice the maximum number of children allowed per Child Care Staff Member. 4. Documentation was not on file for a high school junior or senior who is enrolled in a Child Development Associate (CDA) training program.

4. The child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was expired.
5. The first aid training was expired.
6. The CPR training was expired.
