- 18. Printed name(s)/Dated signature(s) of child care staff member(s) trained to perform the procedure were missing.
- 19. Dated signature(s) of administrator was missing.
- 20. Name of any applicable medication was missing.

- 21. Date medication was administered was missing.
- 22. Time medication was administered was missing.
- 23. Dosage administered was missing.
- 24. Signature of staff member who administered the medication was missing.
- 25. Medication listed in the procedures to follow was not onsite available to administer as instructed and alternate instructions for this situation were not included on the plan.
- 26. The plan was not implemented.
- 27. The plan was not able to be implemented due to conflicting information.
- 28. The plan was not followed.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one child in the Early Preschool group did not wash his or her hands at the time listed in number 7 below, as required in rule.

- 1. Upon arrival.
- 2. Prior to departure.
- 3. After toileting/diaper change.
- 4. After contact with bodily fluids.
- 5. After returning from outdoor play.
- 6. After handling pets, pet cages, or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet, before moving on to another activity.
- 7. Before eating or assisting with food preparation.
- 8. After water activities.
- 9. When visibly soiled (must use soap and water)
- 10. Other.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that outdoor play equipment was unsafe as noted in number 11 below:

- 2. There was protruding bolts;

- 5. There was splintering wood;

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that an entire food group was eliminated for a child, and written instructions from a licensed physician were not file. Refer to the Children Records Review for the names of children who do not have these instructions on file. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Diapering and Toilet Training

Code: The program is required to launder diapers according to manufacturer's guidelines.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program was not storing or laundering soiled diapers or clothing according to the rule, in that the program did not meet the condition indicated in number 6 below.

- 1. Store for no longer than one day
- 2. Store in an individual covered container or plastic bag away from children's belongings
- 3. Kept out of reach of children
- 4. Store soiled diapers and diapering washcloths laundered by the center in a covered container with sanitizing solution
- 5. Hold soiled diapers to be commercially laundered for no more than seven days
- 6. Store soiled disposable diapers in a plastic-lined covered container not easily accessible to children
- 7. Discard disposable diapers daily or more frequently as needed to eliminate odor
- 8. Launder diapers according to manufacturer's guidelines



9. Other.

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all child care staff members complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire. Staff must complete training in first aid and CPR within the first ninety days of hire.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member had not completed required health and safety training as noted in number(s) 1, 2, 3, 5 below:

- 1. Child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
- 2. First aid training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 3. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 4. The child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was expired.
- 5. The first aid training was expired.
- 6. The CPR training was expired.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined a completed medical examination statement for the employee(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart was not on file, as required by this rule. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

- 4. The administrator had not assigned at least one employee or child care staff member to the program's organization dashboard.
- 5. At least one individual's schedule was not current.
- 6. At least one individual's position or role did not include an applicable group assignment.
- 7. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.
- 8. Other.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have at least one administrator named on the license who is onsite for 50 percent of the program's operating hours or 40 hours a week, as required by this rule. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the children's records, it was determined that the JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number(s) 1, 3 below:

- 1. The JFS 01236 had not been updated as needed and at least annually.
- 2. A separate JFS 01236 had not been used for each condition.
- 3. The program used an old version of the JFS 01236.

- nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child
- 8. Medical(s) were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year
- 9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases
- required by division 5104.014 of the Revised Code and found in appendix A to this rule
- 10. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of
- conscience, including religious convictions
- 11. Other.
