## **Complaint Allegations**

## **Domain:07 Diapering & Infant Care**

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Diapering and Toilet Training

Code: The program staff is required to consult with parents about toileting at home and refrain from forcing a child to sit on the toilet or potty chair.

Allegation: The center did not ensure that toilet training occurred based on a child's readiness and consultation with the parent regarding practices in the child's home.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the toilet training practice used by Child Care Staff Members did not meet the requirements of the rule, as noted in number 3 below:

- 1. Children were forced to sit on the toilet or potty chair;
- 2. Parents/guardians were not consulted regarding practices used at home;
- 3. A toddler aged child was offered to reduce their schedule from fulltime to parttime and told they will not be able to return to the program after a specified date if they are not potty trained so they could be moved to the preschool group.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.
