#### Domain:03 Postings & Equipment

Rule: 5101:2-12-17 Materials and Equipment

Code: The program is required to have an area for children to store their belongings.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have designated storage areas for children's personal belongings, in that it was observed that school age children had placed their coats and bookbags in a pile on a bench located near the classroom. Lockers were provided for the children, but were not large enough to hold their belongings. The rule requires that an area be designated where children can individually store their personal belongings. This area shall not block walkways or evacuation routes. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.
