Allegation: Classrooms have chipped paint falling off the walls.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that at least one area of the program or at least one piece of equipment had chipping or peeling paint (Infant 1, Infant 2 & Toddler 1B rooms). Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Infants must be provided with a crib, which meets requirements specified in this rule, for resting and sleeping. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that staff training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
