A staff person harshly grabbed a child by the wrist and arm, dragged them across the room and forcefully placed the child on a chair. There were bruises on the child's arm as a result of the staff person grabbing the child. Child Care Staff Members, administrators, and owners must always use appropriate guidance and management methods with children and ensure that children are safe at all times. The individual needs to be released from employment immediately. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the individual is no longer employed, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
