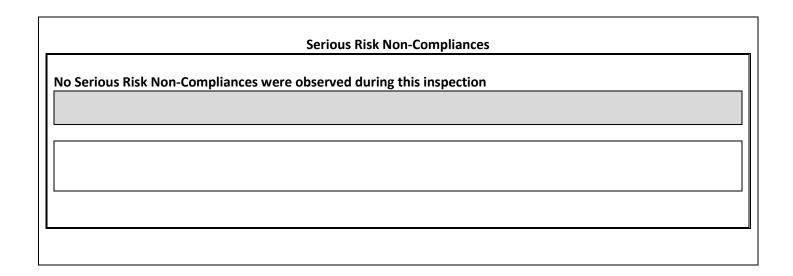

### **Summary of Non-Compliances**

If the program is star rated, the rating may be impacted if a serious or moderate risk non-compliance is cited. Ohio Administrative Code 5101: 2-12-03 details the process for submitting a request for a review if a program disagrees with a licensing finding. The request for review must be submitted within seven days from the receipt of the licensing report.



### **Moderate Risk Non-Compliances**

Domain: 00 License & Approvals
Rule: 5101:2-12-04 Fire Approval

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to only use space approved by the fire department or the state fire marshal's office to serve children. The program is required to obtain a fire inspection within 12 months from the date of the last fire approval. If violations are noted during the inspection, the program is required to have all violations corrected and have the program re-inspected to obtain a completed fire form.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program had not obtained written approval from the local fire safety inspector or the state fire marshal as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. The program had not been inspected and approved within 12 months from the date of the last fire approval and the request for the new inspection was not made at least 30 days prior to the expiration of the previous approval.
- 2. The fire approval had not been obtained due to violations.
- 3. The [ ] space was being used and had not been approved by the fire department or the state fire marshal's office for child care.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes an updated fire approval, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

### **Low Risk Non-Compliances**

#### **Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision**

Rule: 5101:2-12-19 Child Guidance

<u>Code</u>: The program staff shall use developmentally appropriate techniques when managing children's behavior. Corporal punishment is prohibited, as well as any cruel, harsh, unusual or extreme techniques.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a child care staff member used a discipline technique to guide or discipline children that was not developmentally appropriate, consistent, or occurred at the time of the incident. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-19 Supervision

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to meet each child's basic and special needs.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that child care staff did not meet the basic needs of a child as noted in numbers 4 and 5 below:

- 1. Assisting children with toileting;
- 2. Assisting children with hand washing;
- 3. Assisting children with basic hygiene;
- 4. Responding appropriately to a child in distress;
- 5. Assisting a child wiping his/her nose;
- 6. Washing a child's face;
- 7. Assisting a child in tying his/her shoes;
- 8. Assisting a child in changing his/her clothes when needed.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

### Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

Code: The program is required to have the information listed in rule on all attendance records.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the attendance records did not include the required information listed in number 5 below:

- 1. The name of the child.
- 2. The birth date of the child.
- 3. The assigned group.
- 4. The child's weekly schedule.
- 5. The time (hours and minutes) of each child's arrival and departure to the program, including transportation by the program.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 08/06/2021

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to store chemicals in a place that is inaccessible to children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous substance, which was determined to not present a serious risk to a child, was accessible to children as noted in number 11 below:

- 1. Cosmetics;
- 2. Disinfecting wipes;
- 3. Fish food;
- 4. Hand lotion;
- 5. Hand sanitizer (for children under 24 months);
- 6. Laundry detergent;
- 7. Powder dish washing soap;
- 8. Paint cans;
- 9. White out;
- 10. Potting Soil;
- 11. Other potentially hazardous substance non-toxic pesticide glue trap.

The potentially hazardous substance was determined to be accessible to children in the following area: School Age Classroom

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous substance is no longer accessible to children and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

Code: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number 6 below, were in the Artic PS restroom:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet paper.
- 3. There were no paper towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilets were not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.
- 9. Other [ ].

The restrooms must be kept sanitary at all times. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

### Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Safe Food Handling/Storage

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to refrain from serving food on bare tables and to remove, clean, and sanitize highchair trays when food is served directly on the tray.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not implement safe food handling when serving food as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. Food was served on bare tables for the Pre K group.
- 2. Food was served directly on highchair trays, and the trays were not removed, cleaned, and sanitized between use for the [ ] group.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

### **Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Professional Development Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to obtain at least 6 hours of professional development annually.

<u>Finding</u>: "In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member did not meet the annual professional development requirement as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. The child care staff members had not completed at least 6 hours of professional development.
- 2. Documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule.
- 3. Training topic did not meet the requirements listed in appendix A of this rule.
- 4. Documentation of training did not meet the requirements of this rule.
- 5. Other [ ].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### **Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5101:2-12-07 Administrator Responsibilities/Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program administrator is required to maintain current employee records in the Ohio Professional

Registry.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined employment records were not entered or updated within five calendar days of the change in the Ohio Professional Registry (OPR) as noted in numbers 1 and 3 below:

- 1. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member (including substitutes) had not created an employment record in the OPR for the program.
- 2. The administrator had not assigned at least one employee or child care staff member to the program's organization dashboard in the OPR.
- 3. At least one individual's schedule was not current.
- 4. At least one individual's position or role was not current.
- 5. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.
- 6. Other:[]

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

### **Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

Code: The program is required to have staff complete the required one hour prescribed Child Abuse training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the requirement for the ODJFS one-hour prescribed Child Abuse Training was not met as noted in numbers 1 and 3 below:

- 1. The training was not completed within sixty days of hire;
- 2. The training expired, as it is only valid for two years;
- 3. Not all administrators, Child Care Staff Members, and substitutes have completed the training.
