Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for responding to a communicable disease as noted in number 2 below.

- 1. The program did not follow the instructions on the JFS 08087 "Ohio Communicable Disease Chart".
- 2. The program did not report a communicable disease that is required to be reported to the local health department to ODJFS in OCLQS by the end of the next business day in that the first case of HFM was determined to have occurred on 6.12.23. The local health department was not notified of an outbreak of HFM until 6.26.23.
