### Complaint Allegations

If a program disagrees with a licensing finding, the program may request a review of the finding(s). Code: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

Allegation: It was alleged that center was operating with unsanitary restroom conditions, in that the toilets used by the children were not being flushed in-between each use.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number 5 & 6 below, were in the toddler, preschool, and school age restrooms:

1. There was no liquid soap.
2. There was no toilet paper.
3. There were no paper towels.
4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
5. The plunger was accessible to the children. - in room 7.
6. The toilet(s) were not flushed after each use.
7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
8. There was a strong urine odor.
9. Other [ ].

The restroom(s) must be kept sanitary at all times.
