## Domain:07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

Code: The program is required to have the mattress support in the lowest position and crib rails in the highest position in all

cribs.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the mattress support was not maintained at the lowest position for all cribs when in use, as required. Except when infants are being placed in cribs, removed from cribs, or being soothed, the sides should remain in the highest position. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.
