Rule: 5180:2-12-22 Safe Food Handling/Storage  
Code: The program is required to store and serve food in a safe manner.

Allegation: There are unsanitary conditions in the kitchen, including a child's feeding tube being stored in the refrigerator, along with food to be served to other children.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that food was not stored in a safe manner as noted in number(s) 5 below:

1. The refrigerator did not maintain a temperature of 40 degrees Fahrenheit or below.
2. Milk was not refrigerated for approximately ( ) minutes after being served.
3. Food was observed thawing on the counter.
4. Spoiled food was served to children.
5. A child's bare feeding tube and attached bag of food supplement were observed laying across containers of food in the refrigerator. Additionally, the outside doors of the refrigerator were observed to be dirty.

Code: The program staff is required to use and discard a separation material between each diaper change.

Allegation: A child's diaper was changed in the kitchen, and the soiled diaper was left on the kitchen floor.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, staff denied a diaper was changed in the kitchen; however, a soiled diaper was observed on the kitchen floor in a photo. No separation material between the diaper and the floor was observed in the photo and additionally, the kitchen is an inappropriate area for a soiled diaper at any time. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
