Findings: During the inspection, required staff/child ratios were not maintained for different groups on more than one occasion, as noted below:

The ratio determined for the school age group was one child care staff member for 22 children. Additionally, a ratio of 1 child care staff member for 22 children was determined for the combined preschool/pre-K group.

Additional staff members must be hired or current child care staff members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to maintain the appropriate group size for each group of children served.

Findings: During the inspection, group size limitations were not maintained for the group of toddlers, as it was determined there were 15 children grouped together. (The toddler and Discovery Preschool groups were combined.) The group size shall not exceed twice the maximum number of children allowed per child care staff member. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-12-18 Group Size

Code: The program may combine all age groups when there are twelve or fewer children in the center.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined groups which included children less than two and one half years were combined with groups of children two and one half years and older and there were more than 12 children in the center. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.
