Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store chemicals in a place that is inaccessible to children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous substance, which was determined to not present a serious risk to a child, was accessible to children as noted in number 11 below:

- 1. Cosmetics;
- 2. Disinfecting wipes;
- 3. Fish food;
- 4. Hand lotion;
- 5. Hand sanitizer (for children under 24 months);
- 6. Laundry detergent;
- 7. Powder dish washing soap;
- 8. Paint cans;
- 9. White out;
- 10. Potting Soil;
- 11. Other potentially hazardous substance: several cans of shaving cream.

The potentially hazardous substance was determined to be accessible to children in the following area: on a low shelf in an unlocked cabinet in Room 418. Provide staff training. - 2. Telephone cords.
- 3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 4. Stacked chairs (in the gym).
- 5. Employee purse (in room 421).
- 6. Diaper bags.
- 7. Television not securely anchored.
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
- 10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: [].
