Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child was not isolated (child was observed in the infant room walking around) or discharged for demonstrating symptom(s) listed on appendix B of this rule as noted in number 12 below:

1. Temperature of at least one hundred and one degrees Fahrenheit (one hundred degrees Fahrenheit if taken axillary), when in combination with any other sign or symptom of illness
2. Diarrhea as described in rule
3. Severe coughing as described in rule
4. Difficult or rapid breathing
5. Yellowish skin or eyes
6. Redness of the eye or eyelid as described in rule
7. Untreated infected skin patches as described in rule
8. Unusually dark urine or stool as described in rule
9. Stiff neck with elevated temperature
10. Evidence of lice, etc. as described in rule
11. Sore throat or difficulty in swallowing
12. Vomiting as described in rule - child vomited on playground and was brought into the program.
