- 1. There was no method in place;
- 2. The method did not include each child's name;
- 3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
- 4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;
- 5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group.

- 7. Before eating or assisting with food preparation.
- 8. After water activities.
- 9. When visibly soiled (must use soap and water)

- 2. There were tall weeds.
- 3. There was poison ivy.
- 4. There were tree branches.
- 5. There was mold visible.
- 6. There were thistles with prickers.
- 7. There were bird droppings.
- 8. There were bolts with more than two threads exposed along a fence line or gate on a playground.
- 9. The sandbox was contaminated.

10. Other: black ground cover under mulch protruded in strips above the mulch creating a tripping hazard. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
