Code: The program staff shall use developmentally appropriate techniques when managing children's behavior. Corporal punishment is prohibited, as well as any cruel, harsh, unusual or extreme techniques.

Allegation: A childcare staff member was observed to use prohibitive child guidance and management techniques.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, the allegation was substantiated. In review of video footage, it was determined that a Child Care Staff Member had used inappropriate techniques when managing unacceptable behavior in children. A childcare staff member was observed to physically push a child into a restroom and block the doorway to prevent the child from leaving. This staff member was also observed to forcibly push a child's head onto a table. Another child was forcibly pushed onto their cot and was held on the cot. Child Care Staff Members and other employees must always use appropriate guidance and management methods with children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
