Code: The program staff used in ratio are to refrain from other duties that would not allow them to provide appropriate care and supervision of the children in their group.

Allegation: Child care staff were on their phones when used in ratios.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that Child Care Staff Members who were used in the staff/child ratio were engaged in other duties, texting on their phones, and, therefore, were unable to provide appropriate care and supervision to the children. The allegation was substantiated. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5180:2-12-16 Incident/Injury Reporting

Code: The program is required to complete the JFS 01299 "Incident/Injury Report" for injuries and incidents at the program, provide a copy to the person who picks the child up on the day of the incident, and retain a copy of the form onsite at the program for one year.

Allegation: An incident/injury report was not provided to the parent/guardian, on the day that their child sustained an injury at the center.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for completing a JFS 01299 "Incident/Injury Report" in that the parent or a person picking up the child did not receive the JFS 01299 on the day of the incident. The allegation was substantiated. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
