Rule: 5101:2-12-19 Child Guidance

Code: The program staff shall use developmentally appropriate techniques when managing children's behavior. Corporal punishment is prohibited, as well as any cruel, harsh, unusual or extreme techniques.

Allegation: Teachers are not using appropriate guidance and management techniques.

**Determination**: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child care staff member used a discipline technique to guide or discipline child(ren) that was not developmentally appropriate, consistent, or occurred at the time of the incident. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-19 Child Guidance

Code: The program is required to report in OCLQS when a child is expelled from a center for a behavioral reason.

Allegation: Teachers are not using appropriate guidance and management techniques.

**Determination**: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child had been expelled for a behavioral reason and the expulsion was not reported in the Ohio Child Licensing Quality System (OCLQS), as required. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the expulsion has been reported in OCLQS, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of the rule.

Code: The program is required to complete the JFS 01299 "Incident/Injury Report" for injuries and incidents at the program.

Allegation: Incident reports are not being completed and provided as required.

<u>Determination</u>: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a JFS 01299 "Incident/Injury Report" was not completed by child care staff for the situation(s) listed in number 4 below:

- 1. A child became ill or received an injury which required first aid treatment.
- 2. A child was transported for emergency medical care.
- 3. A child received a bump or blow to the head.
- 4. An unusual or unexpected incident which jeopardized the safety of a child or employee of a program.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.
