Domain: 00 License & Approvals

Rule: 5101:2-12-04 Fire Inspection

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all spaces used for child care inspected by the fire department or the state fire marshal's office prior to serving children. The program is required to obtain a fire inspection without any uncorrected violations within 12 months from the date of the last fire inspection. If violations are noted during the inspection, the program is required to have all violations corrected and have the program re-inspected to obtain a completed fire form.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for fire inspection as noted in number 1 below:



1. The program did not have documentation on file for a fire inspection from the date of the last fire inspection and the request for the new inspection was not made at least 30 days prior to the expiration of the previous fire inspection.

2. The documentation for the most recent fire inspection contained violations that had not been corrected.3. The [] space was being used and had not been approved by the fire department or the state fire marshal's office for child care.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes an updated fire inspection without any uncorrected violations, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a method for tracking the children in each group. The tracking method must be updated throughout the day and kept with the group at all times.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the method for tracking children in each group did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number 5 below:

- 1. There was no method in place;
- 2. The method did not include each child's name;
- 3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
- 4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;
- 5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group.

It was stated, by the administrator, that there were two school age children in attendance for before school care. The two school age children were not signed in at arrival nor signed out when they left for school. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a clean and healthy environment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following unsanitary conditions were at the program:

- The walls on the second floor were dirty.

- The changing pad on the first floor was torn, preventing appropriate sanitation.

- Floor tiles on the second floor had chipping corners, preventing appropriate sanitation.

A clean and healthy environment, including furniture, materials and equipment must be provided, and the program shall be cleaned daily. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Handwashing Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all children wash their hands as outlined in rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one child in the [] group did not wash his or her hands at the time listed in number 3 below, as required in rule.

- 1. Upon arrival.
- 2. Prior to departure.
- 3. After toileting/diaper change.
- 4. After contact with bodily fluids.
- 5. After returning from outdoor play.

6. After handling pets, pet cages, or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet, before moving on to another activity.

7. Before eating or assisting with food preparation.

- 8. After water activities.
- 9. When visibly soiled (must use soap and water)

10. Other [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment <u>Code</u>: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that cots were not cleaned, as required. Cots, pads, and mats need to be cleaned with soap and water and sanitized prior to reassignment, when used by a sick child, when soiled, and at least every three months. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item(s) or condition(s) which may threaten their health, safety, or well-being as noted in numbers 3, 7 (in the downstairs classroom), below:

- 1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 2. Telephone cords.
- 3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 4. Stacked chairs.
- 5. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 6. Diaper bags.
- 7. Television not securely anchored.
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
- 10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: [].
- 12. Pieces of plaster was observed on and beside the carpeted stairs on the second floor, room to the far left.

13. Plastic diaper storage bags were stored within the reach of the children, under the changing table in the downstairs classroom.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that at least one area of the program or at least one piece of equipment had chipping or peeling paint. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 06/17/2023

Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan <u>Code</u>: The program is required to post and implement the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan" when necessary.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the requirements for the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan for Child Care" were not followed as noted in number 1, 4 below:

- 1. The plan was not posted in each classroom.
- 2. The plan was not posted in other spaces used by children.
- 3. The name, address and telephone number of the program were not complete.
- 4. The location of first aid kit, fire extinguishers and fire alarm system, fire alarm pull stations and electrical circuit box were not complete.
- 5. The telephone number for emergency squad, fire department, hospital, poison control program, public children services agency, local health department, local emergency management agency, and police department were not complete.
- 6. Location of children's records was not complete.
- 7. Emergency information including any medications or supplies needed in the event of an evacuation was not complete.
- 8. The current version of the prescribed form was not used.
- 9. The plan was not implemented when necessary in that [].



The location of the first aid kit on the second floor was inaccurate. The plan was not posted in the room to the right on the second floor. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 06/17/2023

Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan <u>Code</u>: The program is required to post the fire and weather plans.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following information was not posted for item numbers 1, 3 below:

1. Fire alert plan, including a diagram indicating evacuation routes.

- 2. Weather alert plan was missing details for [].
- 3. Weather alert plan was missing a diagram indicating evacuation routes.

The evacuation diagram was not posted in the upstairs middle room and in the main classroom on the first floor. The plan posted in the room to the right and the room to the left were missing the weather diagram. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 06/17/2023

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements <u>Code</u>: The program is required to conduct and document quarterly inspections of their outdoor play space.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that documentation of the quarterly inspections of one or more outdoor play area(s) and equipment, using the JFS 01281 "Child Care Playground Inspection Report" form, could not be located. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 06/17/2023



Domain: 05 Health & Safety

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-16 First Aid/Standard Precautions <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have the appropriate number of first aid kits for the program.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the first aid supplies were not stored according to the requirements listed in item number 1 below:

1. Stored in a clearly marked container, on the second floor.

- 2. Stored in an unlocked container.
- 3. Stored out of the reach of children.
- 4. In each building.
- 5. On each floor.

6 For every 75 children in attendance.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 06 Program Information

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-14 Transportation and Field Trip Procedures <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have parents update routine trip forms annually.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the program's records, it was determined that permission forms for routine trips were not being updated annually, as required. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 06 Program Information

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-14 Transportation and Field Trip Procedures <u>Code</u>: The program is required to obtain written parental permission before leaving the premises.



<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that written parental permission was not secured for a routine trips off the premises or out of the areas approved for child care, as required. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation <u>Code</u>: The program is required to obtain written instructions from parents regarding feeding their infant.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that written instructions for feeding the infants noted on the Children Record Review were missing information as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. Written instructions were not on file.
- 2. Type of food and/or formula/breast milk was missing.
- 3. Amount of food and/or formula/breast milk was missing.
- 4. Feeding times or frequency of feedings was missing.
- 5. The written instructions on file had not been updated.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-23 Diapering and Toilet Training <u>Code</u>: The program is required to launder diapers according to manufacturer's guidelines.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program was not storing or laundering soiled diapers or clothing according to the rule, in that the program did not meet the condition indicated in number 6 below.

- 1. Store for no longer than one day
- 2. Store in an individual covered container or plastic bag away from children's belongings
- 3. Kept out of reach of children

4. Store soiled diapers and diapering washcloths laundered by the center in a covered container with sanitizing solution

5. Hold soiled diapers to be commercially laundered for no more than seven days



6. Store soiled disposable diapers in a plastic-lined covered container not easily accessible to children

- 7. Discard disposable diapers daily or more frequently as needed to eliminate odor
- 8. Launder diapers according to manufacturer's guidelines
- 9. Other []

The lid to the diaper pail was left open. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation <u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to label bottles containing formula or breast milk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that bottles containing formula for an infant were not labeled with the date of preparation. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Daily Care

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a daily written record for each infant in care to the parents when picking up the infant each day.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that there was no daily written record for each infant provided to the parent or person picking up the infant on a daily basis. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.



Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all child care staff members complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire. Staff must complete training in first aid and CPR within the first ninety days of hire.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member had not completed required health and safety training as noted in numbers 4, 5, 6 below:

- 1. Child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
- 2. First aid training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 3. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 4. The child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was expired.
- 5. The first aid training was expired.
- 6. The CPR training was expired.

Refer to the Employee Record Chart for the name(s) of the child care staff member(s) who must complete the required health and safety training(s). Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 09 Children's Files

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records <u>Code</u>: The program is required to use the updated JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care".

<u>Finding</u>: In review of 25% of the children's records, it was determined that information had not been secured from the parent/guardian on the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care", as required, for the items in numbers 2, 4, 6, 10, 12, 15 below.

- 1. No enrollment form was completed for at least one child
- 2. The current JFS 01234 was not completed for at least one child
- 3. Complete child information
- 4. Complete parent information
- 5. Complete emergency contact information
- 6. Complete physician information
- 7. Information regarding the parent list
- 8. Health information
- 9. Additional information for all boxes checked "yes"



10. Emergency transportation information

- 11. Parent/guardian's signature
- 12. Diapering Statement
- 13. Acknowledgement of Policies and Procedures
- 14. Enrollment form for at least one child was not updated by either the parent or the administrator
- 15. Enrollment form for at least one child was not signed by the administrator

Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a completed medical on file at the program for each child enrolled.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of 25% of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statements were not on file, as required, for children listed on the JFS Children's Record Review For Child Care as indicated in number 6 below:

- 1. No medical was on file for at least one child
- 2. Medical(s) on file was not updated every 13 months
- 3. Medical(s) were missing child's name and date of birth
- 4. Medical(s) were missing the date of the medical examination
- 5. The date of the exam was more than 13 months prior to the date the form was signed.
- 6. Medical(s) were missing a statement that the child has been examined and is in suitable condition for participation in group care

7. Medical(s) were missing the signature, business address and telephone number of the physician, physician's assistant(PA), advance practice nurse (APN) or certified

nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child

8. Medical(s) were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year

9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases

required by division 5104.014 of the Revised Code and found in appendix A to this rule

10. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of

conscience, including religious convictions
