Allegation: Some of the classrooms are operating out of ratio.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, required staff/child ratios were not maintained for the same group on multiple occasions, as noted below:

The ratio determined for the combined age group (Infants/Toddlers, Preschool, and School age) was 1 Child Care Staff Member(s) for more than 7 children.

Additional staff members must be hired or current Child Care Staff Members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
