Code: The program staff is required to supervise children in their assigned group by sight and hearing.

Supervision includes being near enough to respond and reach children immediately including responding to the child's basic needs and protecting them from harm.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that children were not being properly supervised as noted in number(s) 1 below:

1. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member during nap time.
2. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member during outdoor play.
3. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member more than once.
4. Staff were not physically present in the space and near enough to respond and reach the child(ren) immediately.

Children must be supervised according to rule and within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member at all times. Provide staff training. 3. The crib is considered hazardous for the child.
