<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a child had been placed in a crib with an object that created a potential strangulation or suffocation risk, as indicated in number(s) 11 below:

- 1. Bib
- 2. Pacifier clip/ribbon
- 3. Teething jewelry
- 4. Blanket for infant under twelve months old

- 5. Pillow
- 6. Boppie
- 7. Bumper pad
- 8. Clothing stored in the crib
- 9. Diaper bag
- 10. Object or toy strung over the crib in which a child can pull himself up
- 11. Stuffed animal that is large/soft enough to conform to the shape of the child's face

The rule prohibits any item which obstructs child-care staff's visibility or poses a risk of strangulation or suffocation from being placed on or in a crib. Remove the item(s) immediately. <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a method for tracking the children in each group. The tracking method must be updated throughout the day and kept with the group at all times.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the method for tracking children in each group did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number(s) 5 below:

- 1. There was no method in place;
- 2. The method did not include each child's name;
- 3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
- 4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;
- 5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that children were not being properly supervised as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member during indoor play/resting in infant.
- 2. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member during outdoor play.
- 3. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member more than once.
- 4. Staff were not physically present in the space and near enough to respond and reach the child(ren) immediately.

Children must be supervised according to rule and within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member at all times. Provide staff training. <u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one piece of equipment, furnishings, or material at the program was not constructed of materials to facilitate cleaning as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The material had a tear (chair in infant).
- 2. The material was not washable.
- 3. The material was porous.
- 4. The surface was cracked.
- 5. The surface was repaired, but in a manner that still did not facilitate cleaning.
- 6. Other [].

Equipment, furnishings, and furniture shall be constructed of materials to facilitate cleaning. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to heat bottles in water 120 degrees or less.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the container of water used to warm bottles was heated to a temperature hotter than 120 degrees Fahrenheit. Bottles shall be placed in a container of water not hotter than 120 degrees Fahrenheit or in a commercial bottle warmer. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

- 21. Transportation for fieldtrips, routine trips (if applicable) and emergencies, including if the center will provide child care services to children whose parents refuse to grant consent for transportation to the source of emergency treatment.
- 22. Water activities/swimming.
- 23. Infant care, if applicable, including feeding, frequency of diaper checks and information about daily activities.
- 24. Sleeping, Napping and Resting.
- 25. Evening and overnight care, if applicable.
- 26. Policy on hours of operation including closing due to weather, school delays or closings and any other factors.
