Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Separation of Children Under 2 1/2 Years

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a group was occupying space not previously approved by the Department for children less than two and one-half years of age. Building and fire department approvals do not prohibit the use of this space for children less than two and one-half years.
