Complaint Allegations

Code: The program staff used in ratio are to refrain from other duties that would not allow them to provide appropriate care and supervision of the children in their group.

Allegation: It was alleged that child care staff members who were used in the staff/child ratio were engaged in other duties.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that Child Care Staff Members who were used in the staff/child ratio were engaged in other duties such as noted in number(s) 4 below and, therefore, were unable to provide appropriate care and supervision to the children:

1. Cooking;
2. Cleaning that interferes with supervision;
3. Paperwork;
4. Talking/texting on the phone;
5. Engaging in a conversation with a parent for an extended period of time;
6. Other [].

Rule: 5180:2-12-09 Background Check Requirements

Code: The program is required to refrain from employing an individual who is not eligible to be employed in child care.

Allegation: It was alleged that a child care staff member was not eligible to be employed.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an owner, owner's representative, administrator, employee or child care staff member, listed on the Employee Record Chart, was not eligible to be employed as noted in number(s) 1 below:

1. The individual had a JFS 01176 ""Program Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care"" on file stating the individual was not eligible for employment and the program allowed the individual to remain employed.
2. The JFS 01178 ""Request for Review of Background Check Decision for Child Care"" had been submitted for the individual and the program allowed the individual to be on-site during the review by ODJFS.

The individual must be immediately released from the program.

Rule 5180:2-12-03 requires the program to notify parents when a serious risk non-compliance is cited. The notification must inform parents of the serious risk non-compliance and include the Department of Children and Youth website and location of further information regarding the determination. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement the individual is no longer employed or a copy of the updated JFS 01176, and a copy of the written parent notification, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
