<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" on file at the program for any child having a health condition and must implement and/or follow instructions on the plan. The program is required to have staff trained to perform the procedures on the JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan for Child Care" present at the program when the child requiring the procedure is onsite. Only staff who have been trained shall be permitted to perform the procedures listed on the JFS 01236.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the children's records, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for caring for at least one child, indicated on the Children Records Review, with a condition that requires a JFS 01236 ""Child Medical/Physical Care Plan"" as noted in number(s) 5,7,11-19,27-31,40,44,45 below:

1. No plan was on file.

- 19. The date of the physician's signature was missing or not attached.

- 42. None of the child care staff members trained in the procedures on the JFS 01236 accompanied the child requiring the plan during a trip.
- 43. A child care staff member who had not been trained in the procedures on the JFS 01236 performed the procedure.
- 44. Medication listed in the procedures to follow was not onsite available to administer as instructed and alternate instructions for this situation were not included on the plan.
- 45. The JFS 01236 had not been updated annually and was an old version.
