Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Group Size

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a signed transitioning agreement in the child's file and transitioning

classrooms.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that children were being transitioned into another group without meeting the requirement listed in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. A signed transition agreement between the parent and center.
- 2. Copies of the agreement available in the classrooms.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the method for tracking children in each group did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number(s) 4&5 below:

- 1. There was no method in place;
- 2. The method did not include each child's name;
- 3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
- 4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;
- 5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide equipment that is safe and hazard free.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, equipment was determined to be unsafe or hazardous to children and in need of repair as noted in number(s) 4 below:

- The equipment had splinters;
- 3. The equipment had protruding nails;

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all child care staff members complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire. Staff must complete training in first aid and CPR within the first ninety days of hire.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member had not completed required health and safety training as noted in number(s) 4&6 below:

- 1. Child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
- 2. First aid training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 3. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 4. The child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was expired.
- 5. The first aid training was expired.
- 6. The CPR training was expired.
